# ADULT COURSES



We offer year round courses for adults which you can start any week of the year. Most students study four hours every day. Classes start at 9.30 and finish at 2.00pm. There's a half hour break. We offer a minimum of 5 levels all year, including Elementary and Advanced. In summer we run a C2 class. Where available, students can also choose to study 2 hours daily.



#### **GENERAL ENGLISH**

General English isn't just grammar – it's designed to improve all skills, especially speaking. These classes are designed to practice reading, listening, speaking, writing, vocabulary acquisition and pronunciation. Our focus is on real world English. If you want to learn English for school, for work or to help you understand native speakers on your holidays, General English is the class for you.

### EXAM PREPARATION
