GENERAL ENGLISH

General English courses are the most popular and in demand courses at Castleforbes College. The student can choose between **15 or 20 hours/week course.**

The 15 hours week course runs from 9:00 to 12:30 (morning) or from 13:00 to 17:00 if you choose the afternoon option (Monday to Thursday)

The 20 hours week course runs from 9:00 to 12:30 + 13:00 to 14:00 of conversation class.

INTENSIVE ENGLISH

The Intensive course allows the student to be in contact with the English all day as it includes morning and afternoon classes with a total of 8 hours per day.

The **30 hours week course** runs from 9:00 to 12:30 + 13:00 to 17:00.

- · All levels are available; from Elementary to Advanced.
- · All our courses are from Monday to Friday.
- \cdot There is a 15 minutes break after the first 2 hours.

ACCOMMODATION



STUDENT HOUSE - SELF CATERING

The capacity of our students houses is for 5, 6 or 7 people. We have single, twins and triples rooms and all the houses are fully equipped with kitchen and a large living room. The houses are located near Castleforbes College, about 10 minutes' walk and many facilities are close by. Our partners ensure, as much as possible, that they mix the nationalities of each house.

Students have to pay a **100€ cash deposit** on their arrival which is given back at the end of their stay if the accommodation was left in good condition.

Rent is calculated on a weekly basis, i.e. from the day you arrive to the same day the following week. Check in/out must be on Saturday or Sunday.

Cleaning: It is necessary for the students of each house to keep the accommodation clean.

If you need to follow a special diet or if you have any allergies it is necessary to provide these details and we will do our best to find a family that best suits your requirements. Host families are located outside the city centre in residential areas. All host families are well connected with Dublin City centre by public transport (20-25 minutes).

Students should arrive to their host families on the Saturday or Sunday before the course starts until the Saturday or Sunday after the course ends. Extra nights are available.

- · Temple Bar Challenge


